Alvirne High School Renovation Plan Approved – The school board has accepted a plan for the proposed high school renovation that will be in a warrant article in March of 2019. The plan chosen was the same plan that missed being voted in last March by a small margin. It primarily focuses on the safety of students and staff at the school and provides for facility updates of a building that was rebuilt in 1975.
